## Public Inputs regarding Programme of Activities

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- The Board at its 41<sup>st</sup> meeting agreed to make a public call for inputs to seek comments on issues associated with the development of the Programme of Activities (PoAs) as a CDM Project Activity and difficulties in the validation and submission for registration of a PoA. The main areas on which public inputs were received are:
  - Application of methodologies including de-bundling;
  - Inclusion of CPAs and DOE liability;
  - Demonstration of additionality;
  - Physical boundary of PoA;
  - Sampling method/procedure;
  - Geographic reference of CPAs;
  - Role of coordinating/managing entity; and
  - Registration request form.

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- Following an initial consideration of a summary of these inputs at its 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting the Board requested the secretariat to prepare options that could address the issues raised for consideration by the Board at its 43<sup>rd</sup> meeting.
- The secretariat has identified three broad areas, which have been the focus of the majority of inputs received. These are matters related to the:
  - Demonstration of additionality;
  - Application of methodologies; and
  - Inclusion of CPAs and DOE liability.
