Background:

- The issue was raised at EB38 by an assessment provided by the secretariat:
 - Different formats used by project participants
 - Lack of specific guidance on how project participants should structure and submit this statement
 - Underlying operational risks unnecessarily increased as a result
- EB requested the secretariat to present a proposal at EB39
- EB requested further inputs on the secretariat's proposal at EB 41 and invited all stake holders through a call for public inputs
- Final draft document including public inputs has been made publicly available as part of the annotated agenda for EB 42

Main components of the proposed guidance:

- Definition of the concept of “focal point”:
- Identification of three scopes of authority for a focal point:
 - a) Communicate in relation to requests for forwarding of CERs to individual accounts of project participants; and/or,
 - b) Communicate in relation to requests for addition and/or voluntary withdrawal of project participants; and/or,
 - c) Communicate on any other matters related to registration and issuance not covered by (a) or (b) above.
- Definition of the concept of “authorised signatory”.
- Types of focal point role:
 - Sole focal point → **only one** focal point entity
 - Shared focal point → **any** of the focal point entities can sign
 - Joint focal point → **all** focal point entities should sign

Main components of the proposed guidance:

- Adoption of the **F-CDM-MOC form** for the submission of statements on modalities of communication.
- Modalities for the introduction and operationalisation of the **F-CDM-MOC**:
 - Changes to the MOC
 - Grace period
 - Restricted public availability (only core statement – contact details, signatures, etc., only available to PPs, DOEs, and other registered users of the CDM-IS).

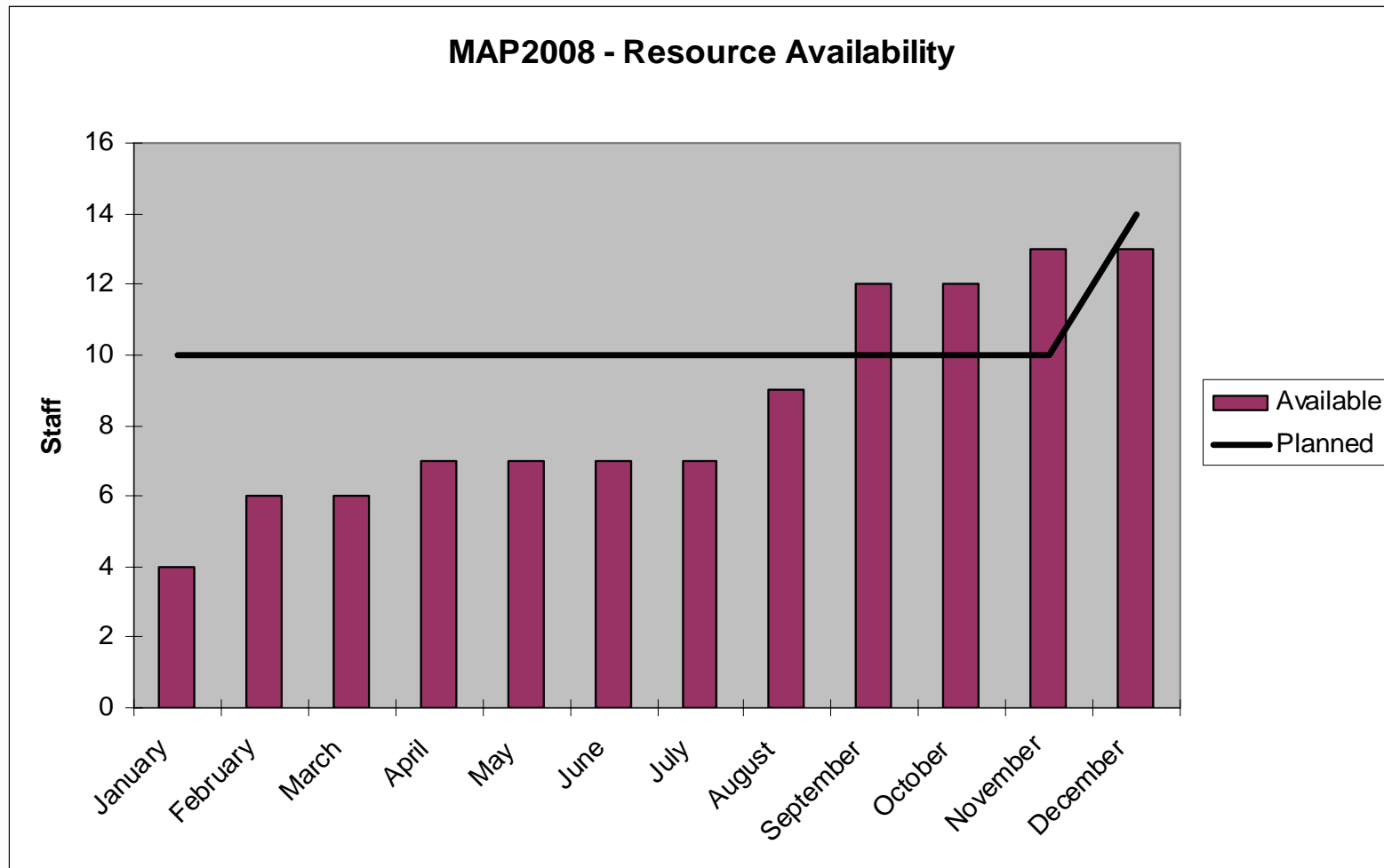

Progress Report on Timeline of Registration & Issuance process

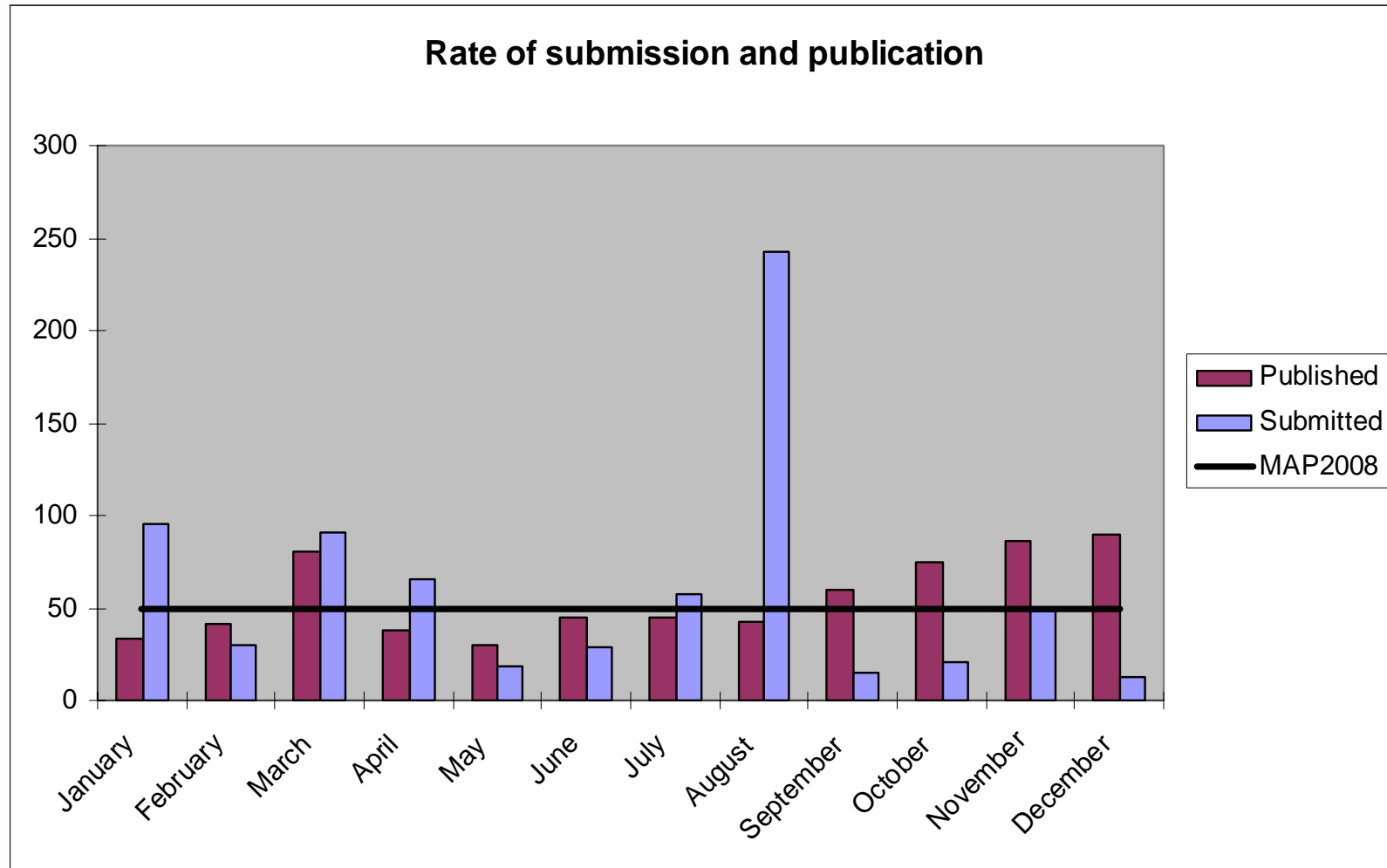
