Project design documents (PDDs)

155 PDDs have been published for comments:

- Emission reductions 2008 - 2012: ~ 280 million tonnes CO₂ equivalent
- Various technologies:
 - Renewable energy (biomass, wind, hydro)
 - Methane avoidance (gas distribution, landfills, coal mine)
 - Destruction of nitrous oxide from chemical processes (nitric acid production)
 - Energy efficiency (manufacturing industries, district heating)
 - Fuel switch (manufacturing industries, transportation, power generation)
 - Power generation (modernization of power plants)
- Host Parties:
 - Bulgaria (12 projects)
 - Estonia (4)
 - Germany (2)
 - Czech Republic (1)
 - Hungary (2)
 - Latvia (1)
 - Lithuania (7)
