- 2 inputs by IEs

- Request to Mr. Geletukha, Mr. Hubenthal and Mr. Leguet to prepare draft revised guidelines for users of the JI PDD forms (supported by secretariat)

Suggested revisions

Basis

- Guidelines for users of JI PDD, JI SSC PDD and JI LULUCF PDD forms
- Inputs received
- JISC discussions

Revisions suggested

1) Establishment of baseline and monitoring plan / additionality demonstration

- **Step-wise approach** (theory, application and proofs, as appropriate)
- **Differentiation** between application of:
approved CDM methodology (incl. deviations) and JI specific approach
- (Optional) **presentation of data/parameters** using the **current CDM structure**,
incl. clear statements regarding timing of determination/monitoring (ex ante/post)

Reasons: clarity and transparency

Suggested revisions

2) Glossaries of JI terms

- Consolidation in **separate document**

Reasons: transparency and comprehensiveness

3) Further issues

- Explicit indication of **sectoral scope(s)**
- Further “minor” changes (e.g. regarding project description, project boundary definition etc.)

Reasons: clarity and transparency
