## Project design documents (PDDs)

170 PDDs have been published for comments:

- Emission reductions 2008 - 2012: ~ 300 million tonnes CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- Various technologies:
  - Renewable energy (biomass, wind, hydro)
  - Methane avoidance (gas distribution, landfills, coal mine)
  - Destruction of nitrous oxide from chemical processes (nitric acid production)
  - Energy efficiency (manufacturing industries, district heating)
  - Fuel switch (manufacturing industries, transportation, power generation)
  - Power generation (modernization of power plants)
- Host Parties:

  - Estonia (5)
  - Germany (2)
  - Czech Republic (1)
